Volunteers

Volunteers are an integral part of our community and we deeply appreciate all of them!

We offer **various volunteer opportunities** that fit multiple time commitments and preferences.

Volunteers at SafeHouse Denver are committed to supporting survivors' healing and journey to a violence-free life.



Non-Direct Service Opportunities:

- **Evening-of Event Volunteers:** Short, one-time opportunities for individuals or small groups to help fundraising events run smoothly. Typically 4-6-hour commitments.
- **Donor Thank You Calls:** Monthly calls to donors to thank them for their donations and recognize their impact.
- **Community Events:** Assist with tabling at occasional community events such as Pride, Colorado Black Arts Festival, and more.
- **Committees:** See next slide



Fundraising Event Committee Opportunities:

Activities such as *auction solicitation* and *event planning* are great options for a shorter-term opportunity that substantially impacts survivors.

Committee members are *required to attend a monthly one-hour meeting*, usually held virtually, with two meetings scheduled a month before the event.

In addition, committee members *commit 3-5 hours a month for procuring gifts*.
