



Donor Privacy Policy

SafeHouse Denver places a high priority on the safety and privacy of our donors, clients, volunteers, and friends. As a result, SafeHouse Denver will not sell, share, or trade donors' names or personal information with any other entity, nor send mailings to donors on behalf of other organizations.

This policy applies to all information received by SafeHouse Denver, both online and offline, as well as any electronic, written, or oral communications. All donor information is confidential and kept on file in a secure database for auditing purposes. Credit card numbers are used only for donation processing and are not retained for any other purpose. To the extent any donations are processed through a third-party service provider, donors' information will only be used for purposes necessary to process the donation.

SafeHouse Denver utilizes donor information to distribute donation receipts and thank-you letters, inform donors about other opportunities within SafeHouse Denver to support survivors of domestic violence, provide updates on our programs, or for internal analysis or record keeping. We publicly recognize donors by publishing names in our Annual Report, which is also placed on our website, unless a donor explicitly requests to remain anonymous. Donors may contact us at info@safehouse-denver.org or 303-302-6116 to request that they not be included in future publications.
